

Dear Parent/Guardian,

The New London- Spicer School District will be implementing a Positive Behavior Intervention and Support (PBIS) system in order to create a positive environment. PBIS is a program designed to teach students appropriate behavior in a school setting. Our school is focusing on *respect, ownership, positive attitude, and responsibility* which we remember by the acronym R.O.A.R. By acknowledging these positive behaviors we will enhance student learning. Students will be encouraged to exhibit these behaviors and will receive a "R.O.A.R. Track" when any staff member sees them doing so. Students will then have the opportunity to "spend" these "Tracks" for rewards. We will be collecting behavior data and using it to evaluate and revise our behavior support system.

Misbehaviors have been divided into 3 levels. Level 1 behaviors result in a student receiving a behavior offense ticket and the consequences as stated in my classroom discipline plan. Level 2 behaviors result in a student receiving a behavior ticket which will be recorded in the office and communicated to parents. Level 3 behaviors also mean the student will receive a behavior ticket which will be referred to the principal for consequences. These behaviors and consequences will be recorded and communication with parents/guardians will occur.

## Consequences

### Level 1 Violation

- 1<sup>st</sup> Offense: Verbal Warning
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense: Behavior Ticket issued and discussion with teacher
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense: Behavior Ticket issued and discussion with teacher
- 4<sup>th</sup> Offense: Behavior Ticket issued, Ticket recorded in the office, and parent(s) contacted

\*This is now considered a Level 2 Violation\*

### Level 2 Violation

- 1<sup>st</sup> Offense: Behavior Ticket issued, Ticket recorded in the office and parent(s) contacted
- (2 additional Level 2 Violations within a 5-day span will be considered a Level 3 Violation)

### Level 3 Violation

- 1<sup>st</sup> Offense: Behavior Ticket issued, Ticket recorded in the office and referred to the principal for further consequences. Parent(s) contacted by principal.
